

Plein Air Painting Suggested Supply List

Everyone should bring the following: Fold-up canvas type chair, Digital Camera, Water Bottle, Sun visor hat, Sun Block Lotion, Lunch, snacks. It will be helpful to be able to carry all of your painting supplies in a small canvas bag to transport from spot to spot easily. Optional items are a view finder/catcher. Also, a jacket for the cool morning air.

Watercolors:

Watercolor Paints (I use a travel kit or pan watercolors) and Brushes
Water Tub (collapsible is nice)
Lap Clip Board

Paper Towels
Tape
Mechanical Pencil Eraser

Sketch Paper
Watercolor Paper Pad and/or Notecards
T-square Ruler

Oils or Acrylics

Oil Paints or Tube Acrylics and Brushes
Canvas Pad or Panels about 8 x 10
Turpentine or Container for water
Retarder (acrylics)

Easel and/or Lap clip board
Paper Towels
Palette Knife
T Square Ruler

Mechanical Pencil
Eraser
Palette Paper or Water Palette
Dry Box (for oils to keep separated while drying to transport home) -optional
